The minimum work call [load-in, performance, load-out] will be 8 hours.

Fort Worth Production Services, Inc. is the Payroll Agent for the Local.

32% of the gross total amount will be added to the bill to compensate for payroll taxes, administration cost, Liability, Worker's Comp, and Health Benefits

9% of the gross total amount will be added to the bill for Annuity Fund benefit.

**Advance payment of the Estimated Payroll total is due prior to the beginning of the load-in.**

DEPARTMENT HEAD (carpenter, electrician, props, audio, video) applied from production load-in to load-out HIGH TIME - applied for work performed 25 feet or higher above the stage floor KEY POSITIONS - Head Flyman, Spotlight Operator, Fork Lift Operator, - Light Board operator, Sound Board operator BREAK - applied when break not given after 2 or 2-1/2 hours of work	2.00
P2 - PREMIUMS-these premiums are to be added to the applicable rate and are per hour. MEAL - applied when a meal or meal break is not provided after five (5) consecutive hours KEY POSITIONS - Camera Operator; Ground Rigger (1-P2 per two hours) RIGGING - (3 hour min.) applied for work performed in the grid, structure, or suspended from a building MIDNIGHT RIGGING - shall be listed as two(2) P2s for every hour between 12 midnight & 8 am PLATFORM RIGGING - (1-P2 per 2 hours worked ) performed from a lift at a height less than 40 feet MIDNIGHT PLATFORM RIGGING - applied for platform rigging for every hour between 12 midnight & 8 am MIDNIGHT & HOLIDAY TRUCK LOADING -per hour worked between 12 midnight & 8 am, and all day on Holidays	12.00
TRUCK RATES - Rates are per person per truck; for each truck loaded or unloaded T1 - the first truck/vehicle loaded or unloaded and/or any truck over 24 feet [4 loaders min] T2 - any truck 24 ft or smaller; or any vehicle other than a truck (bus, car, van, pickup - 2 man min) TRUCK WAITING - applies when loaders must wait two (2) hours before beginning to unload or load the first truck, or between unloading or loading one truck and loading or unloading the next.
